Alyce Murrell (52) a native of Hertford County, departed her earthly life on March 24, 2021 at her residence in Capitol Heights, Maryland. She was the daughter of the late Naomi Murrell Bunch. Alyce received her formal education in the Hertford County Public Schools, graduating in 1986. She continued her education at Elizabeth City State University where she received a BA in Sociology. She was employed as a recreational and social coordinator with Seabury Resources for the Aging. Alyce was passionate and always cared about other people. The LORD called Alyce to the ministry in 2012 and she was ordained as an Elder at HOPE Deliverance Ministries in Millville, Delaware. 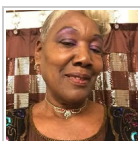
