



## Curtis Flood

April 6, 1932 - June 2, 2014

Curtis Flood was born in Ahoskie, North Carolina to the late Everett “Jack” and Virginia Flood on April 6, 1932. He was preceded in death by six siblings.

He served in the US Armed Forces for four years with his most significant assignment being in Okinawa. After his tour of duty he returned to high school to graduate from R. L. Vann High, Ahoskie, North Carolina.

He worked as a barber for most of his adult life, retiring at the age of 82.
