Harriet Jordan Davis was born January 4, 1937, in Ahoskie, NC, to the late Cordy Jordan Sr. and Anna Christine Weaver Jordan. She passed away peacefully on April 24, 2022, with her family by her side. Harriet graduated salutatorian of her class from C.S. Brown High School, Winton, NC, in 1954. After high school she continued her studies and received her B.S. degree from Hampton University.

In 1957 Harriet married the late Milton E. Davis of Norfolk, VA. In 1965 she moved to New Jersey and followed her passion and was a high school math teacher at Dunellen High School. After 35 years of teaching, Harriet retired and relocated to Richmond, VA, in October of 2000, shortly after the passing of her husband.
